EPOSTERS

New in 2020, all accepted posters will be presented as electronic poster presentations (ePosters). Authors have the option to submit 3 - 5 slides or a PDF to our ePoster hosting site, Morressier. All accepted posters must be submitted digitally in advance of the meeting. If you have included a video in your poster, you will need to submit PowerPoint files (.pptx)

SURGICAL VIDEOS

UPLOAD SPECS

All surgical videos must be submitted digitally in advance of the meeting to our hosting site, Morressier. Video content cannot be modified from the version submitted during abstract submissions. **Please be aware that PowerPoint files (.pptx) will only be accepted for surgical videos. Prior to uploading your video, please add an introductory screen to your file. This can be a cover image or a play button.**

POSTER DESIGN

Strong posters focus on communicability, scientific communication and scientific merit/value. Keep the following items in mind when designing your poster:

• Title and author names are easily identifiable

- Research question, background, methods, results, discussion and conclusion are relevant, logical and linked to one another
- Innovative research, rigorous methods and conclusions supported by results
- Engaging, clear and eye-catching poster design
- Formatting is appropriate and logical; graph and tables are clear and easily visible
- Clear information that can be read in 3-4 minutes
