

Hamilton Regional Eye Institute, St. Joseph's Healthcare, Hamilton, in conjunction with Department of Surgery at McMaster University is inviting applications for an oculo-plastic / orbit surgery position.

Responsibilities:

- 1) Provide full oculo-plastic and orbit clinical care for adult and pediatric patients (elective & emergency on-call service)
- 2) Dedicated supervision and teaching of medical students and residents both in the clinic and operating room setting.
- 3) On-going sustained involvement in research activities within the department

Regular operating room time for orbital surgery and minor treatment room time for oculo-plastic surgery will be associated with the position and contingent upon on-going active participation in all of the three domains outlined above.

This is a full-time clinical position within the Hamilton Regional Eye Institute with a part-time academic appointment within the Division of Ophthalmology. Successful candidate must be eligible for certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
