The Department of Ophthalmology and Vision Sciences at the University of Toronto is inviting applications for the position of glaucoma specialist at the UHN-Toronto Western Hospital and the Kensington Eye Institute. The appointment is a full time faculty position with expectation of research and academic work to make up a minimum of 30% of the time. The effective date of this appointment is July 1, 2020.

The successful candidate will provide medical and surgical glaucoma subspecialty care at UHN-Toronto Western Hospital and Kensington Eye Institute with provision of emergency coverage at UHN-Toronto Western Hospital. The candidate will be required to participate in the teaching of medical students, residents and glaucoma fellows and will add to the body of knowledge through original research including clinical trials.

The successful candidate should possess research skills as evidenced by advanced training or a publication history. The candidate must be eligible for an academic appointment at the University of Toronto at the rank of lecturer or higher and be eligible for certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. This position is fully resourced with operating room time, clinic space, minor surgical room time, diagnostics, technical and administrative support.

The University of Toronto is strongly committed to diversity within its community and especially welcomes applications from visible minority group members, women, Aboriginal persons, persons with disabilities, members of sexual minority groups and others who may contribute to further diversification of ideas. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian and permanent residents will be given priority.
