About the opportunity	<p>The Department of Ophthalmology & Visual Sciences at NSHA/Dalhousie University is recruiting for a Foundation Scholar in Retina Research. This position is endowed through the Queen Elizabeth II Health Sciences Centre Foundation. The purpose of the position is to continue the development of a world class research program in retina research at NSHA/Dalhousie University. The appointment will begin September 1, 2020, or as soon as possible thereafter.</p> <p>The responsibility of the Scholar will include expanding and enhancing the Department's existing research programs in clinical retina research by better understanding disease pathophysiology, its detection, progression and development of effective treatments in the fight against retinal diseases, a major cause of blindness.</p> <p>The successful candidate will hold an MD and/or PhD and have a proven track record of successful research in the field. The candidate will have a recognized potential as a researcher with an excellent publication record and demonstrate an ability to attract research funding. The incumbent will be an innovative team builder who will foster collaborative and multidisciplinary research initiatives and mentor young investigators. They will promote departmental research initiatives through successful grant competitions and the development of partnerships with public and private sectors, both nationally and internationally.</p> <p>The appointment will be for a five-year term and renewable pending satisfactory review. The successful candidate must qualify for an appointment at the level of Assistant or Associate Professor in the Department of Ophthalmology & Visual Sciences at Dalhousie University.</p> <p>Submissions received before July 15, 2020 will be given full consideration. Applicants should submit a cover letter, a current curriculum vitae, a statement of teaching and research interests, and the contact information for three referees.
