OPHTHALMOLOGIST – Medical and Surgical Retina Specialist
Calgary Zone, Alberta Health Services

The Department of Surgery, Alberta Health Services – Calgary Zone, and the University of Calgary, is seeking a Locum for a Medical and Surgical Retina position. The locum would provide service coverage within a group practice from July 1, 2021 to Dec 31, 2021. Requirements include an MD, a fellowship in the Royal College of Physician and Surgeons of Canada in Ophthalmology or an FRCSC equivalent, and retina fellowship training in medical and surgical retina (1 year minimum, 2 years preferred). The ability to contribute and support subspecialty services in uveitis, oncology, pediatrics and inherited retinal diseases will be required. Medical and surgical education will be integrated into the clinical service model. Applicants must be eligible for medical licensure in Alberta.

The successful candidate must have demonstrated specific proficiency in all aspects of Medical and Surgical Retina and Ophthalmological care. The candidate will be expected to provide service coverage within the retina groups' community based office practice and support collaborative care within AHS hospital and CSF surgical units as required. Contributing to the on call coverage will be expected within the greater retinal group.
