

### LOCUM POSITION Medical and Surgical Retina Specialist Dept of Ophthalmology, Western University Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry

The Dept of Ophthalmology at the Ivey Eye Institute, St Joseph's Health Care London, and the Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry at Western University invite applications for a temporary clinical locum with associated part-time adjunct/MD academic position in Ophthalmology as a Medical and Surgical Retina Specialist from May 06, 2024 to November 30, 2024.

# **Qualifications:**

- Candidates must hold an MD or equivalent and be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO).
- Specialist certification in Ophthalmology from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) or equivalent is required.
- Candidates must have completed a minimum of two years fellowship training in Medical and Surgical Retina.

## **Expectations**:

- Management of retinal diseases in the outpatient service.
- Surgical management of retinal diseases Operating Room time will be provided
- Full participation in the retina on-call schedule (1 in 4).
- Active involvement in teaching, both at undergraduate and postgraduate levels (supervising residents, Grand Rounds, Retina Rounds, lectures).

### The Ivey Eye Institute:

The Ivey Eye Institute is the main referral centre for eye disease in Southwestern Ontario. The department currently comprises 21ophthalmologists, offering ophthalmic care across multiple subspecialties in a single location with 4 surgical retina specialists and 2 non-surgical retina specialists. It serves a population of close to 2 million people.

Western University offers a full range of academic and professional programs, with a full time enrollment of about 31 000 students. Established in 1881, the Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry was one of the founding schools of the university.
