

The Island Health Department of Surgical Services is seeking a general / comprehensive ophthalmologist to join the Division of Ophthalmology in beautiful Victoria, British Columbia.

The successful candidate will hold Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada certification in Ophthalmology and be eligible for full licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of B.C. Applicants must also have graduated from the Canadian Ophthalmology program or equivalent. Previous work experience is an asset.

Responsibilities will include: providing comprehensive medical and surgical ophthalmology care (glaucoma, diabetes, pediatrics, cataract, etc.).

The successful candidate would have equitable access to OR time for the purposes above (the division standard is one day OR per week in the outpatient ambulatory centre), and access to outpatient testing and treatment including: fluorescein angiography unit, ophthalmic ultrasound, diode and YAG/SLT/Argon lasers and a fully equipped treatment room for minor surgical procedures. There is a requirement for the successful candidate to establish a community based practice.

Full participation in the on call schedule (1 in 12) is an expectation of this position.

There is also an expectation that the successful applicant would participate in medical student teaching and would be provided and an appointment to the UBC Faculty of Medicine.
