Remuneration is Fee for Service and HOCC for call. The successful candidate will be given resources equivalent to a 1.0 FTE position, including regular OR and ambulatory care time. A one-time relocation stipend is also offered as part of our onboarding process.

There are dedicated OR resources for cataracts and complex ocular cases. Our ambulatory care department has a treatment room for minor procedures fully equipped with a YAG and Diode laser. Should the successful candidate choose, there is the opportunity to join an established practice equipped with three exam rooms, two full-time technicians, and in-office capabilities for intravitreal injections, use of YAG/SLT laser, and advanced diagnostics, including OCT, IOLM biometry, topography, visual field, and fundus camera.

The successful candidate will be part of the regional call group covering LHIN 12, which is currently 1:7.
