CEI is Ontario's largest private ophthalmology group: a 7-site, nearly 40 MD/OD practice serving a catchment of ~7 million patients and 13 Ontario hospitals. We house every major subspecialty (except pediatrics) and provide comprehensive optometric services.

Role & Scope

- **Primary focus:** Medical and surgical glaucoma (e.g., MIGS, trabeculectomy, tube shunts, cycloablative procedures), longitudinal glaucoma care, and comanagement across CEI.
- **Complex anterior segment** (e.g., IOL exchange/scleral fixation, iris repair, pupilloplasty, zonular support) is a **significant asset** and will be supported.
- **Cataract surgery:** Resources available for surgeons who wish to maintain or expand a cataract practice (including refractive options).
- **Sites:** Services provided across at least **two CEI locations** with a primary focus on **Newmarket, ON**.
- **Surgical resources:** OR access via our sister ASC, **Lumea** (Vaughan, ON). Expect a minimum of 2 **OR days/month** initially, with potential to expand based on demand and case mix (glaucoma and cataract).
- **Team coverage:** Participate in coverage for emergent patient care during colleague absences and assist with regional ocular emergencies.

Qualifications

- Eligible for **independent practice licensure** with the **College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO)**.
- **FRCSC** (Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada) in Ophthalmology.
- Completion of a **glaucoma fellowship**; additional training/experience in **complex anterior segment** strongly preferred.
