The candidate must have completed a surgical glaucoma fellowship. Also, the candidate must have a valid certificate of registration for independent practice from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario as well as a fellowship in Ophthalmology from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.
