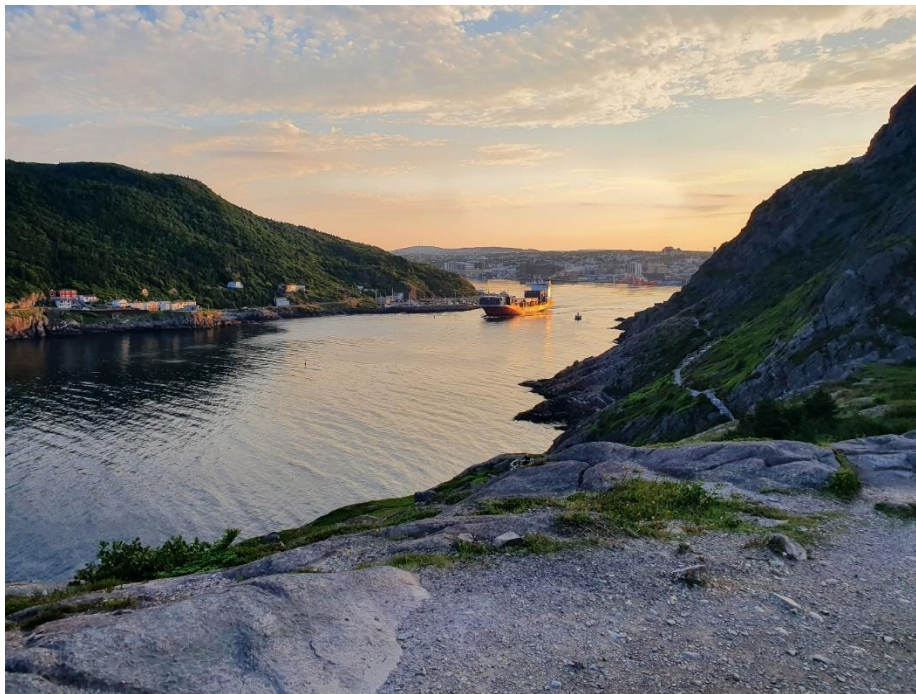


The Division of Ophthalmology, in conjunction with the Department of Surgery for the Newfoundland and Labrador Health Services, is seeking an ophthalmologist with subspecialty expertise in vitreo-retinal surgery to join our team in beautiful St. John's, NL.

An equal share of dedicated retina operating time is available for the successful candidate (currently approx. 1.5 day/week) for retinal procedures, with additional time available after hours as needed. One half day per week is allocated in the NLHS Eye Clinic for minor procedures, lasers, and injections, etc. Establishing an outpatient private office is required, though some local clinics may have space to share if desired.

Providing on-call services is a requirement of this position. Affiliation with Memorial University of Newfoundland medical school is available.



St. John's is the capital of Newfoundland and Labrador. We are home to over 300,000 people in the Greater St. John's area, and have all of the amenities of a big city with a more local feel. House prices range from affordable \$300,000 family homes to \$1+ million for larger estate homes. while watching whales breach or hike the coastal trails; the Grouse Grind in Vancouver or the Bruce Trail in southern Ontario cannot compete with our local East Coast Trail, a network of over 336 kms of ocean-view trails, all within 5-20 minutes of the downtown core. Whether it be local artists in local pubs or our nationally recognized Art Gallery and Museum, with programming for adults and children, we have a thriving arts and cultural scene as well. Vibrant restaurants are also available for the foodies, including our world-famous Mallard Cottage.

Job opportunities are plentiful in many sectors from information technology, manufacturing, and geology, among many others. An international airport is also located within 10 minutes drive from downtown or the hospital.

Moving allowance is provided by the health region, and bursaries may be available.

Requirements:

- FRCSC certification in ophthalmology, or FRCSC eligibility.
- Minimum 1 year post residency vitreo-retinal surgery fellowship
- MD degree from a recognized university.
- Eligible for full independent licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Newfoundland and Labrador.
